In memory of the life and contributions of Dr. Bruce W. Davis, the SPE Los Angeles Basin Section along with the Davis Family are pleased to announce that a \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduate student this school year.

The Dr. Bruce W. Davis Memorial Scholarships will be awarded to candidates pursuing her/his graduate studies or conducting research in petroleum related fields at the University of Southern California (USC), including petroleum or chemical engineering or chemistry. Dr. Bruce W. Davis considered himself an experimental chemist from day one of his life and enjoyed a 26-year career with Chevron as a Research Petroleum Engineer. Hence, we wish to encourage students with a research or experimental science background to pursue a future career in the petroleum industry.

The award recipients may reapply for an award as long as he/she maintains a GPA of 3.3 or above in their major field of studies and other qualifications can be verified before the application deadline. Verification of the applicant's information may be supplied from various references, professors and school administrators.

All applications should be submitted to this same address. Please use the undergraduate/ graduate student college scholarship application form and indicate clearly for Bruce Davis Scholarship application. A graduate student at USC may apply for both the Bruce Davis and SPE Graduate Student Scholarships using one application, but can only win one.

The deadline for submittal of the completed application: **April 9, 2010**
Decision will be at board meeting May 10, 2010.
